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#### NOTES TO THE STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT

#### Basis of accounting

The net amount chargeable to the Department of Education amounts to €162,596.700 (2012: €162,047,256) and includes €15,000,000 (2012: €15,000,000) payable to Bus Éireann. This balance was calculated on 13% of total costs to an agreed maximum of €15,000,000.

The costs are the direct costs in respect of the Schools Transport Scheme. Direct costs for this purpose exclude amounts charged in respect of depreciation and interest on Bus Éireann - Irish Bus vehicles. In arriving at the amount chargeable for scheduled services, the factor for absenteeism has been taken into account at 4.5%.
